





Plotting History from a position

Have you ever wanted to see on a map where your vehicle goes after you look at a single point in the history? After running the history for a vehicle, go to the Grid View icon on the top of the new website. It is the far left icon on the toolbar shown below.




When you click on the Grid View it will show you all of your history with a Location field that is a hyperlink to the mapped position of that location. If you click on one of the Locations, it will map that position for you with a blue dot and a dancing orange pin (shown below).



The orange pin will disappear after a few seconds and you will be able to click on the blue dot to bring up the right hand panel showing the Event that you just clicked on. This has all of the standard information to it, the name of the vehicle, the speed, location and some options for that position.

One of the options that you can choose from is **Replay from here**.

When you select that option the system will automatically plot all of the locations that the vehicle has been and bring you into the playback history and put the history up to that position. You can now use the playback buttons (shown below) to move forward or backward from the one position that you started with.



When you are done looking at the history, just click on the blue camera icon and that will close the playback feature and you will be back to the map showing the history position you were at.

Quick Tip - Vehicle Location Sharing (Mobile App)

Ever want to share the location of one of your vehicles with someone via text or email?

Using MSTMobile (our iOS and Android app) you can share the location of a vehicle with someone else via text or email.

While in our app, click on the vehicle that you want to share the location for and scroll down and you will see SHARE in blue letters. This will bring up your mobile device's options to Message/Text someone or email someone. Choose which option you want and it will prepare the message.

The information that will be sent to the person is the name of the vehicle, the current speed, the event that last happened (ignition on/off, Travel Start/Stop, etc) as well as an address, latitude and longitude as well as a map link to Google Maps to make it easy for the person to find where your vehicle is at the time that you sent the message.
